

**SUMMARIZED MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF COLORADO CITY COUNCIL
MEETING HELD MONDAY, AUGUST 17, 2020, AT 25 SOUTH CENTRAL STREET,
COLORADO CITY, ARIZONA**

Meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m. by Mayor Joseph Allred.

Roll call showed present: Mayor Joseph Allred, Vice-Mayor Anthus Barlow (arrived 6:08 pm), and Council Members Alma Hammon, Ralph Johnson, Donald Richter, Joanne Shapley, and Jeffery Jessop.

CANVASS OF ELECTION

Town Manager Vance Barlow presented the results from the 2020 Primary Election. He explained that there would not be a General Election for Council seats this year. All the candidates had received more than 50% of the votes. The 3 highest vote getters will seat. There was a 20% voter turnout. Current Councilmembers will finish out their terms and the new members would be sworn in and seated at the December meeting as per Arizona state law.

Thomas Holm- Nothing to say at this time.


