** A Statement of Organization is only filed when the committee criteria are met, and it is no longer automatically required at candidate filing.

*** This is a statutory deadline. Check with county on deadline. Your county should be consulted for other deadlines if the county is assisting in the conduct of your election.

**** Deadline falls on a Sunday or legal holiday and is moved to the next business day.
